This means having more treatment options that can make a world of difference in the lives of both you and your pet. Comprehensive Workup

Electrocardiogram (EKG)

A non-invasive test for the diagnosis of abnormal heart rhythms and overall heart function.

Radiographs (X-rays)

It is important to check to be sure:

- The heart is at a normal size
- The lungs are free of masses
- The spine and joints are healthy

Urinalysis

Includes physical, chemical and microscopic evaluation of urine. This provides valuable information about kidney and liver function as well as the general wellbeing of the animal.

Blood Work

Often allows us to detect illness in your pet before we can see any outward signs of disease. Testing healthy pets gives us normal baseline values to compare to later.

Glaucoma Screen

To make sure your pet's eye pressure is normal. Increased eye pressure can cause the eye to enlarge and lead to irreversible blindness.
